The Salvation Army owns and manages a substantial holding in the Kaiwera District, near Gore, that was bequeathed by the late Mr Jeff. Applications will be considered from all young people who wish to study at Telford Rural Polytechnic. Priority will be given to those students who need assistance because of their financial situation, living circumstances or state of health. The awards include study fees, meals and accommodation, funded to a maximum of 80% of total costs. Applications close **31st August**.

This bursary to the value of \$500, is available to a student intending studying towards a Telford Certificate. Applicants must have been enrolled as a Telford STAR student or STAR e-Learning student, while attending high school. **Applications should be made at the time of enrolment.**

Telford Rural Polytechnic – Equine Lease Fee Bursary

\$600
(Equine)

This bursary is available to a Certificate in Equine student who leases a horse from Telford during their year of study. This bursary is worth \$600 and covers the cost of the lease fee. The student will have their lease fee reimbursed once 10% of the course has been completed. **Applications should be made at the time of enrolment.**

Telford Rural Polytechnic - Horse Transportation Bursary

This bursary is a contribution towards the transportation costs incurred as a result of bringing a horse to campus.
